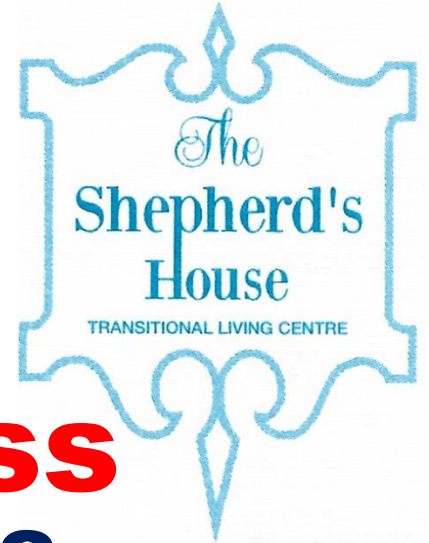




Autocross For The Veterans

Silent Auction & Solo Autocross May 20, 2018



Autocross • Driver registration from 7:45 to 8:45am with first car on course at 10:00am

Silent Auction • Bidding will begin at 8:00am and end at 2:30pm
• You must be present at the end of the auction to win

Ride-Alongs • Dream Makers Automotive will be giving ride-alongs in an exotic car
• \$5.00 fee per ride • Rides will start at 10:00am and take place throughout the day, happening between solo driver runs. A limited number of rides will be available and will be on a first come, first served basis

4000 Parnell Ave in Fort Wayne • Entirety of event will take place in the parking lot
• Bring your own chairs • Seating is NOT provided

Cash Donations • All cash donations will earn entries into prize drawings • Everyone in attendance (drivers and spectators) will receive one free entry
• Winners will be drawn at the conclusion of the autocross runs. You must be present to win
